



2004-05 Classic Soccer Program

Tualatin Hills United Soccer Club is proud to announce our Fall Classic Soccer Program. Starting with tryouts on May 2nd, we offer the serious soccer player an opportunity to continue to develop their soccer skills and knowledge in preparation for future success. This yearlong program continues through April 2005.

Our comprehensive training program for U11-U14 players includes:

- Summer Team training 2-3 days per week.
- Fall Team training 2-3 days per week.
- Flexible Winter Training Academy running December through March. Players are able to attend 1 to 4 days a week.
- Spring Team Training 2-3 days per week.
- Functional Friday/Positional Training and Goal Keeper Training.
- Speed and Agility Training.
- All club administrative and coaching fees.
- One week summer Club Camp in July.
- Unity Week Camp.
- Director of Coaching Training.
- All field access fees, including the use of the Athletic Center, field 1.
- Referee Fees for all League Play.
- Training t-shirt.
- Participation fees for OYSA Fall League play.
- Participation fees for OYSA Spring League play.
- Participation fees for OYSA Qualifying Tournaments in August.
- Participation fees for the 2004 United Cup Tournament.

Expenses not included in this program include the following:

- Uniforms and personal equipment.
- Participation fee and travel expenses for any other tournaments.
- Indoor Soccer Participation fees. (if your team participates)

The player participation fees:

- Full payment of \$1025 may be made by personal check and is due by 5/20/04. (checks payable to THUSC and mailed to address below or bring to Club meeting on the 20th)
- An installment payment plan is available through PreEnroll.com, using automatic deductions from a credit card. The total cost using this payment plan will be \$1050. The first payment of \$420 is due by May 20, 2004; four more payments of \$157.50 each will be automatically charged to your credit card on 6/18, 7/18, 8/18 and 9/18. (you may link through www.THUSC.org – link via register on line or go directly to www.PreEnroll.com)
- Uniform fee (if needed) of \$190 is due in full by 5/20/2004. This payment may be made via check or credit card when using PreEnroll. The uniform package includes sweats, 2 pair shorts, 2 jerseys, socks and an equipment bag. (Checks should be made to THUSC and mailed to Darrell Sabin /3083 NW 126th Pl, Portland, 97229)
